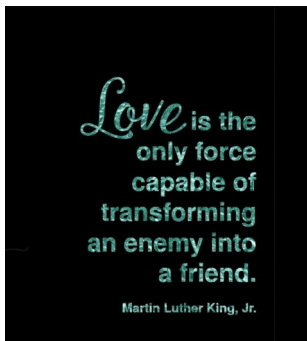

The Perfect Pastime

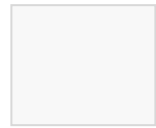
